Overall Purpose of Job

- Assist with feeding to include addressing catering needs and could include making tea and toast, supervision of patient's meal and special dietary requirements.
- Ambulates, positions and turns patients as well as caring for patients with altered mobility.
- Assists with patient safety related to age and condition
- Assists with patient specific safety precautions, collects, reports and documents data related to
 patient needs, emergencies and unusual patient and family behaviour, and cares for the patient

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from a correctional environment

- Maintains patient privacy and confidentiality of information and records at all times.
- Provides and maintains a clean, safe environment and performs and/or assists others to perform proper aseptic technique, isolation procedures, and infection control measures
- Maintains patient care areas with appropriate supplies
- Performs techniques and routines in the specialty service area.
- Performs or assists others to perform proper aseptic techniques, isolation procedures, and infection control measures.
- Adheres to internal controls established for department.
- The timely identification and communication of any issues to the Nurse Manager, Clinical Co-Coordinator or Nurse in charge
- Participate in Unit and hospital communication processes {unit meeting, staff forums and so forth}
