- To perform cardiology procedures or tests when deemed appropriate by the Consultant Cardiologist.

- Support other departments' Consultants when cardiology opinion or review is requested and inform the On - Call Cardiologist of any issues or problems.
- To protect and enhance the reputation of the Beacon Hospital. To implement quality standards ensuring the provision of quality service.
- To comply with Health and Safety Regulations, ensuring safe working practices in a safe working environment.
- To participate in Hospital Quality Improvement and Risk Management Initiatives.
