Overall Purpose of Job

Day to day operations

- Facilitate planning, implementation and evaluation of patient flow initiatives to enhance patient care delivery and patient satisfaction.
- Promote a customer service approach
- Assist the VP, Patient Care Services in the development of policies and goals that address patient care operations.
- Assist in Patient Pathway Planning

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Management

- Oversee the management of inpatient units, Floors 3 to 6 inclusive as well as the Day
 Oncology and Emergency Departments so that they run effectively and efficiently in
 delivering exceptional patient care.
- Provide direction and support to direct reports by identifying, analysing, and refining clinical and system processes and operations to improve and ensure positive patient outcomes
- Promote the ongoing Professional development through academic and clinical learning.
- Collaborate with professionals across UPMC nationally and internationally to identify and support educational opportunities.
- Develop nursing leaders and participate in successful planning activities. Create a structure and necessary support that promotes and allow for staff input and consideration.
- Participate in workforce planning and employment decisions including selecting talented nursing leaders, mentoring others and applying appropriate corrective disciplinary actions to mitigate workplace behaviour problems.

Relationships with others

- Develop effective working relationships with Consultants so that the needs of their practice are continuously met
- Develop relationships and integrate all team members into the team's work.
- Work closely with NCHDs so that they understand day to day Hospital operations
- Establish and maintain good rapport and cooperative relationship with peers, nursing staff, hospital staff, medical staff, management, and others.

Quality and Patient Safety

- Contributes to the development and maintenance of a professional practice environment to achieve positive patient care outcomes and staff satisfaction.
- Articulate and ensure compliance with patient care and nursing standards established by regulatory agencies (An Bord Altranais, and the Joint Commission), as well as hospital patient care standards and standards published by professional organizations.
- Utilise hospital data management systems to access information and analyse data in planning for patient care processes and systems.
- Lead problem solving teams around clinical improvement issues and recommend changes as required to support the delivery of quality patient care.

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- Determine patient care quality improvement goals and objectives.
- Monitor clinical activities to identify unexpected risk and implement patient safety
 initiatives. Demonstrate initiative to address complex, high risk problems and translate them
 into opportunities and challenges. Share nursing sensitive quality outcomes in appropriate
 leadership forums.
